1. Approved minutes from January 18, 2006 RCNJ Leadership committee meeting.
2. **President's report** – Nandy mentioned that invitation card for the 03/08/2006 dinner featuring Dean Alan Cramb should be in your hands now. A special round of thanks to RCNJ Vice President John Cloninger '96 , Nandy and the Lurie family for producing and preparing invitations for mailing. We sent out 3000 invitations for the dinner. We need to publicize our events better and increase attendance. RCNJ elections will be held in June. Please begin thinking about if you would be interested in serving as an officer of the RCNJ.
3. **Vice President's report** – No report.
4. **Treasurer's report - Financial update** – Treasury numbers were discussed. Dues have been collected from over 90 alumni. Liberty Science Center wants to raise funds for their summer program themselves.

**5. Discussion of events since last committee meeting (Nets basketball game, Princeton Hockey game) -**

On Saturday January 21, 2006, eleven members of the RCNJ attended the New Jersey Nets men's basketball game against the Boston Celtics. All who attended had a good time, as the Nets defeated the Celtics, 103-83.

On Saturday February 17, 2006, approximately 135 members of the RCNJ attended the RPI men's ice hockey game at Princeton. This marked the 26<sup>th</sup> consecutive year that the RCNJ held this event. The RPI Engineers raced out to an early 2-0 lead, but the homestanding Princeton Tigers scored the next four goals of the contest. Rensselaer tied the game with two goals late and the game ended in a 4-4 tie. Following the game, approximately 40 people gathered at a local Chinese buffet for socializing and a post game meal. Among the attendees at the buffet was the RPI Pep band.

6. **Discussion about upcoming events** – As of 02/27/2006, we have 17 people paid to attend the dinner on 03/08/06 featuring RPI Dean of Engineering Alan Cramb. Nandy sent out an e-mail to all RCNJ dues payers encouraging people to attend. Members of the RCNJ Leadership Committee will also be making phone calls for this. There was a bit of discussion about whether it was stated at 01/18/06 meeting that RCNJ would subsidize each attendee for the dinner \$10, hence making each person's cost to attend \$50. In hindsight, this may have resulted in increased attendance and Lurie and Nudelman did recall making the suggestion to do so. However, when it came time to print the invitation cards, this discussion point was forgotten and each attendee was asked for \$60 to attend. In summary, at the 03/20/06 meeting, we will discuss the dinner and have a post-mortem, discussing what went well and what the RCNJ can do to improve its process for holding dinner functions in the future. Special thanks to all RCNJ Leadership Committee members for all their input, suggestions and assistance in terms of the dinner.
